Each dog gift box and bed is filled with essentials that new pet parents need most.

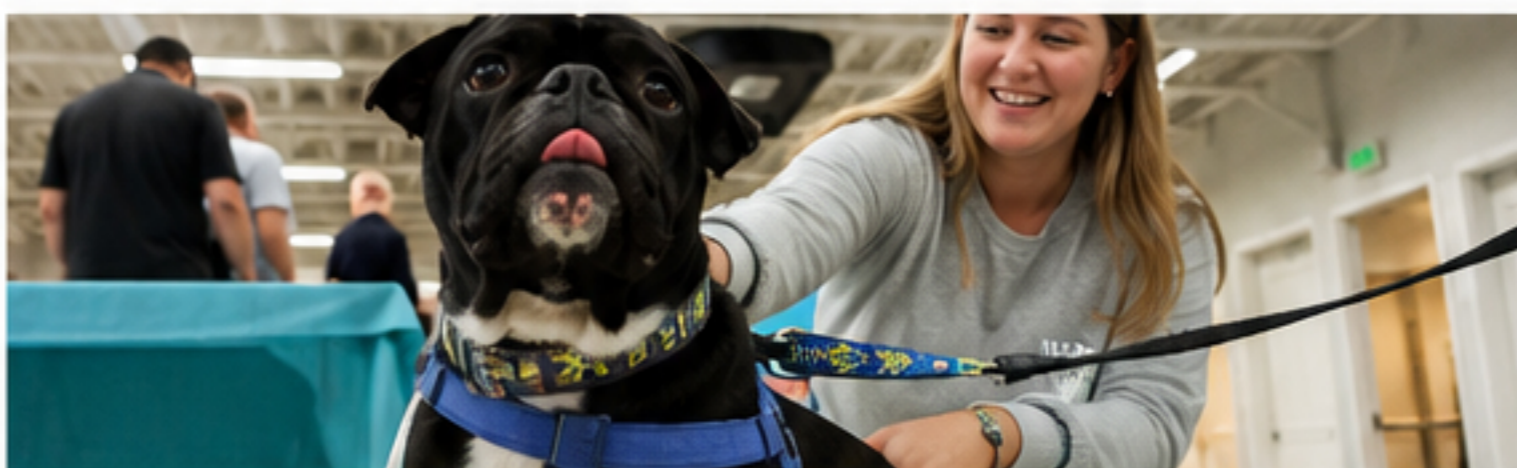
